Disabled Parking Policy

In accordance with the Fair Housing Act, the Board of Directors has adopted a Disabled Parking Policy.

The resident must submit a written request with a copy of their DMV issued disabled permit. It will be either the placard (hanging tag) or a copy of the current vehicle registration indicating the resident has disability license plates for their vehicle. Both sides of the placard (hanging tag) must be copied to show to whom the permit is issued and the expiration date.

Temporary Disability permits will be a form issued by DMV showing a starting and ending date.

Both the DMV permit and a current Fairlington Villages parking sticker must be displayed for the vehicle to be valid.

Once the letter is submitted Management will install a disabled parking sign in the resident's parking lot. However, the Board has final approval on all disabled parking requests.

Any vehicle in violation will be towed by Management.
